Psychometric and Learning Difficulties Assessments

- Psychometric Assessment involves testing to ascertain potential intellectual functioning
- The Learning Difficulties Assessment involves tests of academic performance

Additional assessments include:

- Assessments for auditory processing disorders, neurodevelopmental delay,
- QEEG (Quantified Electro-encephalogram)
- TOVA (Test of Variables of Attention)
- IVA (Integrated Visual & Auditory Continuous Performance Test)

Parent and teacher questionnaires together with a full developmental history is necessary in order to determine just what combination of assessments is required.
